## Cheviot to Hook Up With Cincinnati Police Radio System

Police cars operated by Cheviot and the Cheviot police station, Harrison-av, will be equipped with short wave radio receivers to obtain signals of Station X, it was announced Monday by Charles Jacobs, Cheviot safety director and John Blandford, Cincinnati safety director.

The hookup is a part of the Regional Crime Commission's plan to obtain speedy apprehension of criminals in this area. Station X will broadcast messages for Cheviot police when the occasion demands.
