RADIO SET PLACED ON CITY AMBULANCE

Facilities of Station X, Extended to General Hospital, Get Practical Test

Radio facilities of Station X were extended to General Hospital Monday.

Through the use of a receiving set on the hospital ambulance it is believed much difficulty will be eliminated in-directing the ambulance driver to the scene of an emergency call.

The equipment was given its first practical test Monday while Roy Crawford, driver, was en route to the West End to pick up an obstretical case on Barr-st. As he was making the run the hospital was asked to send the ambulance to a Carlisle-av address for another obstetrical case. Station X was notified, and Mr. Crawford was directed, by radio, to take both mothers to the hospital.
