MOTOR, TRAFFIC POLICE MERGED

42 Men to Form Safety Patrol; Central Registration

Bureau Is Planned

Downtown traffic officers and the Safety Patrol, about forty-two men in all, are to be combined in the Safety Patrol under Maj. Wolsefer, Police Chief Weatherly revealed to-day in announcing reorganization moves. Headquarters will be at the Broadway station of District No. 2.

Auto patrol No. 2 and the police wrecker will be moved to the City Garage to make room for the patrol.

A central registration bureau is being established at Station X, where persons arrested by detectives will be taken directly for registration instead of being registered in the district in which they are arrested.

Part of the clerks of the bureau of records will be moved to the central registration bureau, and the police broadcasting station is being moved to the third floor of City Hall.
