## URGES POLICE CALL AFTER ACCIDENTS

The safest and surest method of caring for auto accident victims is to call Station X and place the responsibility in the hands of police who are equipped for such work, the local Traffic Safety Council warned Tuesday.

The Council issued the statement following a report of an accident in which a person suffered a possible skull fracture, two fractured hips and a pelvis fracture, then was removed to a hospital in a coupe. A police cruiser equipped with a stretcher was only three blocks away at the time, it was reported.

Auto accident victims frequently suffer complications because of unskilled treatment, the Council pointed out.
