Police Radio Calls Cost \$47 Here

DURING THE month of October Covington paid \$23.20 for 116 calls to Station X in Cincinnati, and Kenton county paid \$7 for 35 calls during the same period, it was reported Friday. Newport's cost for 47 calls

Newport's cost for 47 calls was \$9.40 and Campbell county's was \$7.40 for 37 calls, officials

also reported.

City Manager Jack Maynard said that Covington still intends to put the two-way police radio system into effect. A. A. Hohnhorst, Kenton county auditor, said the fiscal court has not decided whether the county will participate with Covington if the latter installs the radio system.

Indications from Newport and Campbell county were that since there has been a reduction in the costs of police radio service out of Station X, the idea of dropping the Station X hookup may be reconsidered.
