
BE STREETCAR SAFE



BIKE SAFETY



Streetcars share the road with cyclists, but streetcar tracks can pose some special challenges for bikes and other wheeled vehicles.



- Cross tracks at right angle or in a straight line.
- Be alert and use caution when riding near streetcars and streetcar tracks.
- Be a safe cyclist always wear a helmet and other protective gear when riding.
- Look and listen...never cross in front of a moving streetcar. Streetcars take longer to stop than other vehicles.
- Use caution tracks can be slippery when wet.
- Beware of the door zone watch for motorists opening vehicle doors into your travel space as you pass; don't swerve into the path of other vehicles or the track gap.



 Special signs are posted along the streetcar route to remind cyclists about the track gap, particularly when turning corners onto the streetcar route.
